

## Tank Right LP tank safety device PN: C-0009

The Tank Right LP safety device is intended to Satisfy OSHA's PPE requirement as outlined in 1910.132

### Limits of use:

- The Tank Right LP safety device is intended to act as PPE as required when changing LP tanks on LP powered devices.
- Temperature range 0°F to 100°F (-17°C to 38°C ).
- Keep device clean, if damaged repair or replace immediately.
- Store unused devices in a clean dry environment in temperature range as stated above.
- Extended exposure to sunlight may distort and degrade material.
- This device serves no other purpose than what is stated.

### Safety:

- NO SMOKING or open flames around LP.
- Familiarize yourself with all safety procedures involved when using LP, LP equipment and LP powered devices.
- Always wear safety gloves to protect from freeze injuries when installing or uninstalling LP tanks.

**Instructions for use: Read all instructions completely. Any person who has not read these instructions is not qualified to use this device.**

Prior to installing the LP tank, locate the Tank Right device. Insert the Tank Right window with the TR logo facing outward. Confirm the notch on the window is also aligned to the notch on the housing device. Use caution when installing the window as it may scratch if mishandled. Pushing gently, maneuver the window between the interior and exterior lip.

Once assembled gently push the Tank Right device over the top of the LP tank, aligning the holes between the LP tank and Tank Right device. Use the provided safety gloves or other suitable safety gloves. LP leaks and blasts can cause injury to hands, face and other body parts. No smoking at anytime.

Carefully lift and install the LP tank onto the tank cradle so that the retainer pin passes through the slot of the Tank Right safety device. While wearing safety gloves, assemble the hose fitting onto the outlet valve making sure it is properly tightened. When the fitting is properly assembled, reach through the butterfly "X" hole and turn the LP valve on. When exchanging or removing the LP tank, even if the tank is presumed empty, wear safety gloves as pressurized LPG gas is still in the hose and can cause injury. Be aware that LP liquid can be emitted from the fitting. After the LP tank has been exchanged your safety gloves can now be stored within the Tank Right device using the butterfly "X" hole for easy storage.

Review - Always wear gloves when installing or removing LP tanks. Never smoke or allow open flame near LP tanks devices or equipment. LP liquid and gas can cause fires, explosions and freeze injuries.

### LIMITED WARRANTY

Tank Right reserves the right to use reconditioned parts and assemblies as warranty replacements for authorized repairs. Any product repaired, replaced, or upgraded pursuant to this Limited Warranty will be warranted for the remainder of the original warranty period.

This Limited Warranty is extended to the original retail purchaser. This Limited Warranty can be transferred to anyone who may subsequently purchase this product provided that such transfer is made within the applicable warranty period and Tank Right is provided with all of the following information: (i) all warranty registration information (as set forth at [www.tankrightsystems.com](http://www.tankrightsystems.com)) for the new owner, (ii) proof of the transfer, within thirty (30) days of the transfer, and (iii) a photocopy of the original sales receipt. Warranty coverage shall be determined by Tank Right in its sole discretion. This is your sole warranty. Tank Right does not authorize any third party, including any dealer or sales representative, to assume any liability on behalf of Tank Right or to make any warranty on behalf of Tank Right.

#### WARRANTY INFORMATION

Tank Right may, at its option, require proof of the original purchase date in the form of a dated copy of original invoice or authorized dealer's invoice or sales receipt.
